

ACADEMIC SKILLS PROGRAM (ASP)

The Academic Skills Program (ASP) is an on-duty education program designed to improve the competencies of active duty and reserve enlisted personnel/dependents in the academic skills of math and reading. ASP is for all active duty and reserve military students who are using tuition assistance for the first time, and who have a GT of 99 or below and failed to achieve a grade of 10.2 on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE). Completion of ASP is required prior to submitting requests for tuition assistance.

Eligibility

- Service members with a GT score of 99 or below has priority.
- Family members with a Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) score of 10.2 or below has priority.
- All other submissions will be granted a seat on a space-available basis before the class start date.
- An ASP Authorization Form must be completed and submitted to the Education Assistance Branch (EAB) with the Commanding Officer's endorsement prior to the course start date.

General Information

- Classes are conducted by Coastal Carolina Community College (CCCC) in the John A. Lejeune Education Center, 825 Stone Street, MCB Camp Lejeune in Room 220 and Room 423.
- All holidays will be observed in accordance with installation schedules and policies.
- The schedule is published annually, however, it is subject to change. Please confirm with EAB for scheduling.
