MASP is an educational program designed specifically for improving the reading, writing, mathematical, and communication skills of military personnel (and family members) from all DoD branches. Successful completion ensures more confident and better prepared service members for their MOS/Ratings, as well as, preparing them for the pursuit of voluntary higher education opportunities.

MASP Evening is comprised of a 6-week class for service members with a GT score of 100 or below and a Test Adult Basic Education (TABE) score of 10.9 or below (**TABE score only for family members**) to be eligible for the program. All other submissions will be placed on a standby list and granted a seat on a space available basis before the class start date. Classes are conducted in the John A. Lejeune Education Center, 825 Stone Street, MCB Camp Lejeune, Room 220, from 1700 to 2100 Monday through Thursday. All holidays will be observed in accordance with MCB Camp Lejeune's schedule and policies. A minimum of 10 students are required for class (25 Max). Commanding Officer's endorsement is required. For more information please contact our office.
