EXAM INFORMATION (Rev 1/19)

JOINT SERVICES TRANSCRIPT (JST): This DoD program offers service members and veterans official transcripts articulating military education and training into academically recognized college credits. The American Council on Education (ACE) may award up to 12 credits based upon the training and education received in the military. Credits may be accumulated for Boot Camp, A-schools, C-schools, MCI/MarineNet courses, occupational specialty/rating, etc. For more information visit <https://jst.doded.mil>.

RATE/MOS CREDENTIALING & LICENSURE: Find out how Rate/MOS relate to certifications, education, and professional development. Obtain vouchers for certifications and register for designated off-base testing sites, and much more. USN site <https://www.cool.navy.mil>. USMC site <https://www.cool.usmc.mil>. Other branches of service have their own cool websites as well.

EBSCO LEARNING EXPRESS: Virtual Library website for active duty/reserve military, families, retirees, and DoD personnel. Hundreds of free study resources and practices exams available to assess your readiness for testing. Contact your base Library for more information. **See separate flier.**

MyVolEdPath: Free downloadable virtual mobile APP for iOS and Android Smart Phones. Connect 24/7 and discover, explore, navigate and choose from multiple educational resources, forums and FAQs designed to meet your educational needs. Available at www.dantes.doded.mil.

ADULT LEARNING LAB/TUTORING: Free personal tutoring and instructional resources available for active duty/reserves, adult family members, and DoD civilians. Must be 18-years of age or older. Contact **910.938.6259** or visit www.tutor.com.

MASP (MILITARY ACADEMIC SKILLS PROGRAM): Four week daytime or six week nighttime refresher courses available. Classes designed to prepare students for college or the ASVAB/AFCT. Curriculum review includes Reading, Writing, Basic & Practical Math, and Communication/Grammar. Computer assisted instruction. Classes conducted in the John A. Lejeune Education Center. Command authorization required for all military personnel. Contact **910.451.3091** or visit your base **Education Center Tuition Assistance Office**.

OASC (ONLINE ACADEMIC SKILLS COURSE): A self-paced program assessing student Vocabulary, Reading Comprehension, and Mathematical skills. Program is comprised of interactive computer-based games, problems, and exercises designed to increase student proficiency. Contact **910.450.9080** or visit your base **Education Center Tuition Assistance Office**.

GED (GRADUATE EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT): A 4-subject computer-based high school equivalency exam measuring Science, Social Studies, Mathematics Reasoning, and Language Arts skills. These exams provide adults, who did not complete high school, an opportunity to earn high school equivalency credentials. Active duty/reserve military may qualify for reimbursement. Tests administered off-base at National Testing Centers (NTC) only. **See separate flier.**

eCLEP (ELECTRONIC COLLEGE LEVEL EXAM PROGRAM): Computer-based exams designed to assess student knowledge in college level general education courses; English, Math, History, Science, and electives. Tests equivalent to a full semester of college classes condensed into 90-minute finals. Most student scores issued immediately upon completion. However, essay exams may take up to 3-weeks for scoring. Exams provide students the option of testing out of general education classes. **See separate flier.**

eDSST (ELECTRONIC DANTES STANDARDIZED SUBJECT TESTS): Series of computer-based exams designed to assess student knowledge in college level general education courses; Social Sciences, Humanities, Mathematics, Physical Science, and Business & Technology. Exams equivalent to a full semester of college classes condensed into 90-minute finals. Most student score reports issued immediately upon completion. However, essay exams may take up to 3-weeks for scoring. Exams provide students the option of testing out of general education classes. **See separate flier.**

TOEFL (TEST OF ENGLISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE): Exam designed to assess foreign (non-native) student abilities to understand and speak English in an academic or business environment. Exam comprised of 4-parts; Reading, Listening, Speaking, and Writing. Colleges, government agencies, businesses, and medical facilities may require exam as a job placement prerequisite. See front of this flier for testing location and contact information.

PRAXIS (TEACHER CERTIFICATION): Series of tests measuring knowledge and skills in a variety of subjects deemed necessary for teacher education programs. Individual State prerequisites may apply. Active duty/reserve military may qualify for a 1x reimbursement for PRAXIS I CORE (partial or complete), and 1x for a PRAXIS II Subject exam, per military career. **See separate flier.**

GRE (GRADUATE RECORD EXAMINATION): Standardized test designed to assess abstract thinking skills in Math, Vocabulary, and Analytical Writing. Not all graduate schools require a GRE. Students should contact their institution for admission requirements. Active duty/reserve military may qualify for a 1x reimbursement for exam. **See separate flier.**

GMAT (GRADUATE MANAGEMENT ADMISSION'S TEST): A standardized exam for graduate business studies. Many MBA programs utilize the GMAT as a prerequisite for enrollment. Exam measures basic Verbal, Mathematical, and Analytical Writing skills acquired through lifelong learning experiences. Students should contact their institution for admission requirements. Active duty/reserve military may qualify for a 1x reimbursement for exam. **See separate flier.**

NC DAP (NORTH CAROLINA DIAGNOSTIC & PLACEMENT EXAM): Assessment/placement test for students enrolling in colleges and universities throughout North Carolina. Replaces COMPASS exam. Exams administered by **Coastal Carolina Community College**. See front of this flier for testing location and contact information.
