

GRE - GMAT - GED - PRAXIS

(DANTES Exam Reimbursement Program) Rev 4/18

Vendor policies and restrictions limit administration of these computer-based exams CONUS to off-base civilian National testing sites only. Students should consult their academic institution for admission prerequisites before testing. DANTES restrictions apply. Reimbursement are only available to active/reserve military personnel. Visit base libraries and online resources for testing information and preparation materials.

GRE:

Graduate Record Examination - Standardized 3-hour computer test measuring abstract thinking skills in Mathematics, Vocabulary and Analytical Writing. Active duty & reserve military personnel may qualify for a 1x reimbursement (per lifetime) for a GRE revised General and GRE Subject. Students make their own testing arrangements and pay all applicable fees upfront. Students must possess a current military CAC I.D. at time of testing. After exam completion, students must complete the online reimbursement form and provide an “**Official – Score Report**” and “**Exam Payment Receipt**” to DANTES. Students have up to 90-days after taking exam for a reimbursement submission. See back of flier for FAQ.

GMAT:

Graduate Management Admission Test - Standardized 4-hour computer exam measuring Verbal, Mathematical and Analytical Writing skills. Active duty & reserve military personnel may obtain a 1x reimbursement (per lifetime) for a GMAT. Students make their own testing arrangements and pay all applicable fees upfront. Students must possess a current military CAC I.D. at time of testing. After exam completion, students must complete the reimbursement form and provide an “**Official – Score Report**” and “**Exam Payment Receipt**” to DANTES. Students have up to 90-days after taking exam for a reimbursement submission. See back of flier for FAQ.

GED:

General Educational Development – Series of four high school equivalency subject exams in Reasoning through Language Arts, Mathematics Reasoning, Social Studies and Science. Students who may not have completed high school have an opportunity to earn their high school diploma credentialing. Exams administered off-base at civilian National Testing Centers (NTC). For additional exam information visit the websites below. Eligibility for DANTES reimbursement, student must be on active duty/reserves at time of testing and must possess a current active/reserve military (CAC) “Geneva Conventions Uniformed Services” identification card to register online. PRAXIS:

PRAXIS I Series & PRAXIS II Subject – Series of tests utilized by colleges for student admissions into teacher degree programs. Individual States may require these exams for certification and licensure purposes. Students make their own testing arrangements and pay all applicable fees upfront. Active duty and reserve military may qualify for a 1x (per lifetime) reimbursement of a PRAXIS I Series (full or partial) and a 1x (per lifetime) reimbursement of one PRAXIS II Subject exam. Students must possess a current military CAC I.D. at time of testing. After exam completion, student must complete the electronic reimbursement form and provide an “**Official – Score Report**” and “**Exam Payment Receipt**” to DANTES. Students have up to 90-days after taking exam for a reimbursement submission. See back of flier for FAQ.

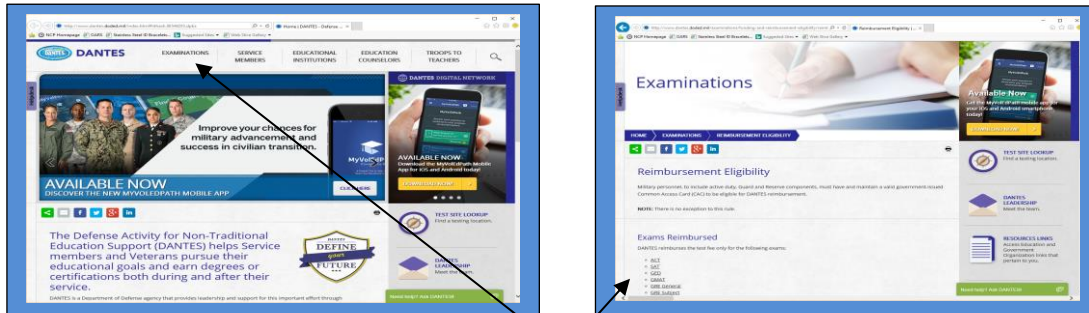

REIMBURSEMENT - FAQ (Rev 4/18)

1. **Reimbursements require CAC Card access:** All exam reimbursement requests must be submitted online via the “**Electronic Reimbursement Form**” available at:

<http://www.dantes.doded.mil/index.html>

All paper editions of the DANTES Reimbursement Form are **OBSOLETE** and will not be accepted. Any paper reimbursement packages submitted will be returned to the service member with instructions to complete the Electronic Reimbursement Form online. To prevent delays or complications carefully read and follow all instructions.

2. **What are the qualifications for reimbursement?** Active duty/reserve military examine must possess a current CAC, “Geneva Conventions Uniformed Services Identification Card.” CAC card is required for online application submission. Service member must also submit request(s) within 90-days of exam completion date.

3. **What fees does the reimbursement cover?** Only the exam fee is reimbursable. All other fees including retests, registration, application cancellation and all other fees are not reimbursable by DANTES. You must provide two documents of verification of exam completion, “**Official Score Report,**” and “**Exam Payment Receipt.**” Both items must be uploaded to the electronic reimbursement form and submitted with your request(s).

4. **What if I took both a GRE and GMAT?** Submit separate request(s) per each exam and provide copies of the “**Official Score Report**” and “**Exam Payment Receipt**” for each test taken. Retest(s) are not covered by DANTES.

- 1x per lifetime: GRE General
- 1x per lifetime: GRE Subject
- 1x per lifetime: GMAT
- 1x per lifetime: PRAXIS CORE (complete or partial)
- 1x per lifetime: PRAXIS II – Subject & Content or Principles of Learning & Teaching (PLT)
- 1x per lifetime: GED

5. **How long does it take for reimbursement?** Processing takes approximately 3-weeks after requests is received by DANTES. Only USCG members will receive reimbursement via a U.S. Treasury check sent to the mailing address provided on form. All other reimbursements will be electronically transferred to individual’s military pay bank account.
