Test Fee: \$85.00 (Per Exam)

Registration Fee: \$28.00 (Per Exam)

Online registration required. Testing availability posted on website. **Registration Confirmation Number** required day of test. Military test 1x free per exam per lifetime. Fees subject to change per vendor policies.

Base Dress Code: Adherence to Camp Lejeune's Base Dress Code required! Inappropriate attire and weapons not permitted in the John A. Lejeune Education testing center. Gang colors, suggestive/revealing clothing, tube tops, spaghetti strap tops, obscene language/logos, beach attire, hats, hoods, bandanas, muscle shirts, tank tops, dirty or ripped/torn clothing, and PT gear prohibited. Management reserves the right to deny testing privileges to any service member or civilian not in compliance.

Authorized Personnel: DoD, Homeland Security, and DANTES policies, restrict eDSST testing to authorized base personnel only! Authorized personnel are active duty/reserve military, military dependents, military retirees, DoD & NAF personnel, and students attending college classes on base.

Military Personnel: Active duty/reserve military test **1x FREE** per each eDSST exam. DANTES does not fund military retesting on previously funded and failed exams. Student is responsible for all retesting fees.

Civilian Personnel: Authorized non-military must pay all applicable fees at time of registration.

Identification Required: Current military identification and other appropriate I.D. (military I.D., driver's license, passport with photo & signature, etc.) required for all administrations.

Times/Dates: Registration, dates, and times of availability posted on the registration website listed above. If you want to change, cancel appointment, have questions, concerns, or problems scheduling exam(s), contact the "HELP DESK."

Length: Most exams are timed 90 to 120 minute multiple choice (excludes "Essay" response). Essay response exams consist of 2-parts; 90-multiple-choice test, and a 90-minute written response. Additional out of pocket \$10.00 essay fee may apply. Students must verify with their school if Essay is required. A minimum of 4 weeks advance notice required for ordering all Essays.

Learning Express (LEX): Preparatory website for active duty/reserve military, families, retirees, and DoD personnel. Hundreds of free practices exams available to assess your readiness for testing. Contact your base Library for more information. Also, visit websites listed below for additional resources.

MyVolEdPath: Free downloadable virtual mobile APP for iOS and Android Smart Phones. Connect 24/7 and discover, explore, navigate and choose from multiple practice exams, educational resources, and forums designed to meet your academic needs visit www.dantes.doded.mil.

Tutoring Services: Students requiring a little extra assistance may utilize readily available online tutoring services. Visit <https://militarytutor.com> click on your (or sponsor) branch of service for details.

Preparation: Exams are the equivalent of a full semester of college classes condensed into 1 to 2 hour final exams. Study materials available at base/local libraries. Practice assessments and additional test information available online. Failure to do well on practice assessment(s) may be indicative of your performance on actual test. Save time and money (if fees apply) and schedule only when you feel confident and ready.

Retests: There is a mandatory 3-month waiting period for exam retakes. Applicable fees apply for all retests. Violation of this waiting period will result in exam voided by the DSST vendor, forfeiture of all fees paid, and an additional 3-month wait from the date unauthorized exam taken.

Scores: At time of exam student may designate one free exam score report to any school of their choice (must provide institution's designated DSST Code). Examinee will receive an instant score report (except for Essay response). Essays require 3-4 weeks for scoring. Transcript will be mailed to student and designated school. Students responsible for paying all additional transcript fees. Visit www.getcollegetcredit.com.
