ONLINE REGISTRATION REQUIRED!

Test Fee: \$87.00 (Per Exam)

Registration Fee: \$28.00 (Per Exam)

(Military personnel 1x FREE per each exam)

Testing schedule posted on website. **Registration Confirmation Number** required day of testing. Per vendor policies Fees subject to change.

Military Personnel: Active duty/reserve military test **1x FREE** per each eCLEP exam. DANTES does not fund military retakes on previously funded and failed exams. Student is responsible for paying all applicable retesting fees.

Civilian Personnel: Authorized non-military personnel must pay all applicable fees at registration.

Times/Dates: Testing dates and times of availability are posted on the website listed above. Contact HELP DESK numbers if you have questions or problems with registration.

Length: Most exams are timed 90 to 120 minute multiple choice (excludes "Essay" response). Essay response exams consist of 2-parts; 90-multiple-choice test and a 90-minute written response. Additional out of pocket \$10.00 Essay fee may apply. Students must verify with their school if Essay is required. A minimum of 4 weeks advance notice required for ordering all Essays.

Preparation: Exams equivalent to a full semester of college classes condensed into 90-minute final exams. Failure to do well on practice assessment(s) may be indicative of your performance on actual test. Save time and money (if fees apply) and schedule only when confident and ready. Study materials available at base/local libraries. Practice assessments and additional test information available online. Be advised these sites are not sponsored nor supported by the John A. Lejeune Education Center. They are provided only as a convenience to students.

Retests: There is a mandatory 3-month waiting period for exam retakes. Applicable fees apply for all retests. Violation of this waiting period will result in exam voided by vendor, forfeiture of all fees paid, and an additional 3-month wait from the date exam taken.

Score Reports: These exams have no bearing on student GPA. Students may designate one free exam score report to any school of choice. Examinee receives an immediate score report except for Essay response which require 3-4 weeks for release and will be mailed student and designated school.
