#### DATA REQUIRED BY THE PRIVACY ACT OF 1974

Disclosure of requested information is solicited under the authority of Title 10, United States Codes 3013, Army Regulation 350-20 and is mandatory. \*\* Per MCO 7222.52F these languages with one modality (listening, reading, or speaking) the Marine must also take an OPI test to achieve the requirement for a combination of two modalities (reading and speaking or listening and speaking) in order to be paid FLPB.

Per MarAdmin 518/18—all languages enclosed in { } will not receive "AUTOMATIC" FLPB PAYMENTS & must request a "SPECIAL PAYMENT" for an operation the marine was used as an interpreter.

FLPP entitlement certification requires that all qualified military must be tested within the last 12 months using the current version of the Defense Language Proficiency Test (DLPT).

The must have a valid military ID card to take the test.

If the service member deploys, go on leave, is released from active service, or assigned temporarily assigned duty (TAD) during the date and time of their assigned test must notify the Military Testing Coordinator, at (910) 451-3092, a MINIMUM of 48 to 24 hours in advance of the assigned test.
