TEST OF ADULT BASIC EDUCATION (TABE) (REV 8/18)

John A. Lejeune Education Center – 825 Stone Street, MCB Camp Lejeune, NC – (910) 451-3092

Marine Corps Order 1200.17A and Military Occupational Specialties (MOS) Manual require service members interested in **MOS 0211 – Counter Intelligence/Human Source Intelligence Specialists (CI/HUMINT)**, and **MOS 2336 – Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD)** to complete either a Nelson Denny Reading Test (NDRT), or a Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) Survey before submitting a transfer request into these MOS fields.

- a. The TABE is a timed 90-minute test of adult basic education measuring a student's current Reading, Language, and Mathematics skill levels.
- b. Maximum score available in each subject is a 12.9+ (high school level 12th year 9th month).
- c. Tests are administered at the John A. Lejeune Education Center, **Room 214** – Coastal Carolina Community College Learning Lab. Hours of operation are **1000 to 1400 hours Monday through Friday**, and **1600 to 2000 hours Monday through Thursday**.
- d. Learning Lab telephone is 910.450.6158. Exam administered on a walk-in basis. *This screening sheet is required for all lateral move TABE administrations.*
