

# Brewster Recreation & Campground Area Rules and Regulations

## **Brewster Campground:**

Brewster Recreation Area is a 122 acre recreation area located along the Northeast Creek River and Brewster Blvd between the base hospital and golf course. The park consists of eight primitive tent camping spaces, one group campsite, and a canoe and kayak launch. Most of the campsites are equipped with a picnic shelter, picnic table, and fire ring. The park offers potable water and port-a-john toilets. **Area is open daily.**

## **Reservations:**

Reservations must be made 48 hours prior to date requested. Reservations are not confirmed until payment is received. Payment may be made at Building 728, in the Outdoor Adventures Office.

## **Fees:**

- Cost per single site **\$15.00** for maximum of 12 people
- Cost per group site **\$30.00** for maximum of 40 people

## **Check in/out:**

Check in will begin after 1200, please contact Outdoor Recreation office with your check in time.

Check out will be on your own before 1100. If late check out is needed, please make arrangements in advance.

## **Fire Permits:**

Ground fires are allowed in a fire ring with a hot works permit given by the base Fire Marshall. (910-451-3004) In order to receive a **Hot Works Permit** you must have a 5 gallon bucket of water and a rack or shovel on your site.

If the National Weather Service issues a red flag for burning or when the base is in a Class V Fire Condition, permits will not be given.

Fires are only permitted in assigned areas.

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## **Leave NO Trace:**

The **Leave No Trace** principles-

- Plan ahead and prepare
- Leave what you find
- Minimize Campfire Impacts
- Respect Wildlife
- Be considerate of other visitors
- Pack in Pack out (take all trash with you)

## **Domesticated Pets:**

Pet must remain with the guest and under the guest's control and in sight at all times.

Owners are responsible for their pet's behavior.

Please clean up after your pet at all times.

## **Children:**

If under the age of 10 must be supervised at all times.

## **Quiet Hours:**

Quiet Hours are between 2200- 0600.

No excessive noise will be permitted at any time.
